SUBJECT: 2025-26 FSAG Summer Disbursements

Institutions are required to return any uncommitted FSAG funds to the Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) within 60 days after the end of the regular registration period for the spring term. An exception may be granted to those institutions opting to use their remaining funds for FSAG summer term disbursements. Additional funds will not be sent specifically for the subsequent summer term.

Institutions opting to disburse FSAG summer term awards must complete the online Summer Disbursement Request form within 60 days after the end of the drop/add registration period for the spring term. The form may be accessed online at <https://www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org>. Once logged in, select Postsecondary Institutions, then select FSAG Summer Disbursement Request under PSI Reporting.

To be eligible for a summer term disbursement, the student must:

- Meet FSAG eligibility requirements for 2025-26;
- Have been disbursed FSAG in the previous fall or spring term of 2025-26; and
- Not exceed the annual FSAG award amount.

A summer term award is for the summer term following the fall 2025 and spring 2026 terms. Summer term disbursements must be reported in Term 6 on the Disbursement Eligibility Report (DER) within 30 days after the end of the summer term. All remaining undisbursed funds must be refunded to OSFA within 30 days after the end of the summer term.
