The Bright Futures Scholarship program allows Bright Futures Florida Academic Scholars (BFFAS) and Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholars (BFFMS) to receive award funding for summer 2026.

Specifically:

- BFFAS students will receive an award that covers 100 percent of tuition and specific fees at a public institution or a comparable amount at a nonpublic institution for the 2026 summer term.
- BFFMS students will receive an award that covers 75 percent of tuition and specific fees at a public institution or a comparable amount at a nonpublic institution for the 2026 summer term.
 - BFFMS students enrolled in an associate program at a Florida College System (FCS) institution will receive 100 percent of tuition and specific fees.

Funding Requirements

In order to receive summer funding, Bright Futures students:

- Must be enrolled at an eligible postsecondary institution as a degree-seeking student; and
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours across all summer sessions.

If you are planning to attend an eligible Bright Futures institution during summer 2026, **update your online account and select Term 0 for the 2026-27 academic year** with the institution where you will be considered degree-seeking. - Select the login link located in the upper right corner;
- Enter your login credentials;
- Select the **Students** menu; and
- Under **Student Account Information**, select **Update Profile**.
