The Florida Department of Education, Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) is pleased to provide the online **2026-27 Renewal Eligibility Application for Institutional Participation in State Scholarship and Grant Programs**, which will be available **May 1 – June 4, 2026**. Section 1009.46(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 6A-20.002(1)(j), Florida Administrative Code, requires postsecondary institutions to annually complete this application for evaluation to receive state financial aid funds.

- Go to **Login** and select **Postsecondary Institutions**.
- Select the **Institution Renewal Application** link, located under **Institutional Information**, to access your institution's Renewal Eligibility Application.

- Review and update the prefilled application information.
- Provide information in mandatory fields marked with an asterisk.
- Submit the completed application online no later than **June 4, 2026**.
