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General Information about the Renewal Application

State Board of Education Rule 6A-20.002(1)(j), Florida Administrative Code, requires that the Postsecondary Institution Renewal Application (Application) for institution participation in State Programs be completed annually to continue participation in Florida State Scholarship and Grant Programs.

The Application must be submitted online and users are encouraged to use the HELP links.

To access the Application, visit the Office of Student Financial Assistance website at https://www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org. Login and select **Postsecondary Institutions**, then select the **Institution Renewal Application** link in the Institutional Information section.

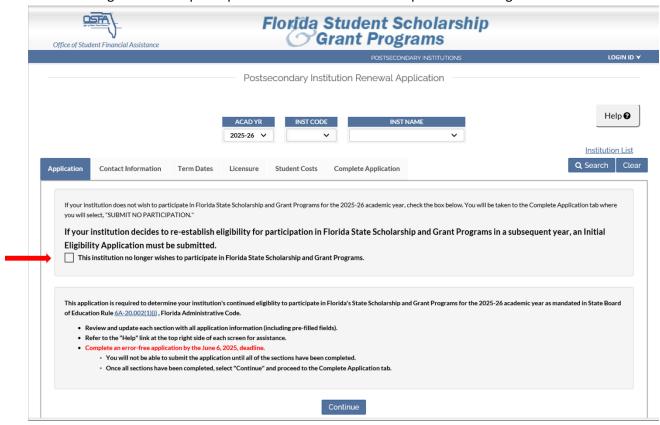


The Application is divided into the following sections: Contact Information, Term Dates, Licensure, Student Costs, and Complete Application.

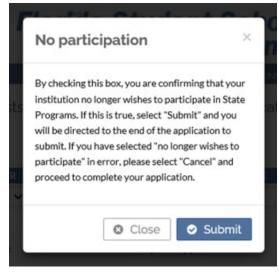


Non-participation

If an institution does **NOT** wish to continue participating in State Scholarship and Grant Programs, select, "This institution no longer wishes to participate in Florida State Scholarship and Grant Programs."

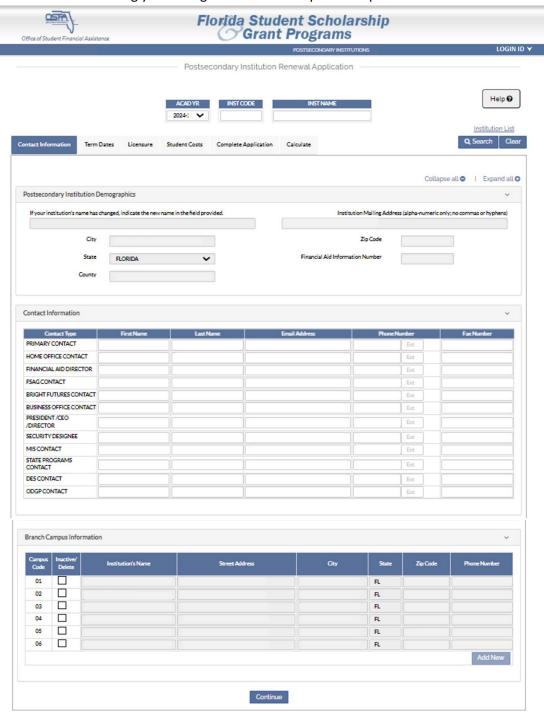


The user is automatically given a popup to confirm non-participation. By selecting "Submit," the user will be directed to the end of the application for final submission and processing. If the institution prefers to participate instead, select "Close" and continue to complete the application.



Contact Information

Review pre-filled information and update where necessary. Check the accuracy of name and contact information. OSFA strongly encourages institutions to provide a point of contact for each contact type.



Term Dates

This information affects allocations, disbursements, grade and hours, and program eligibility.

Term dates are used to establish the institution's disbursement reporting and refund/reconciliation due dates.

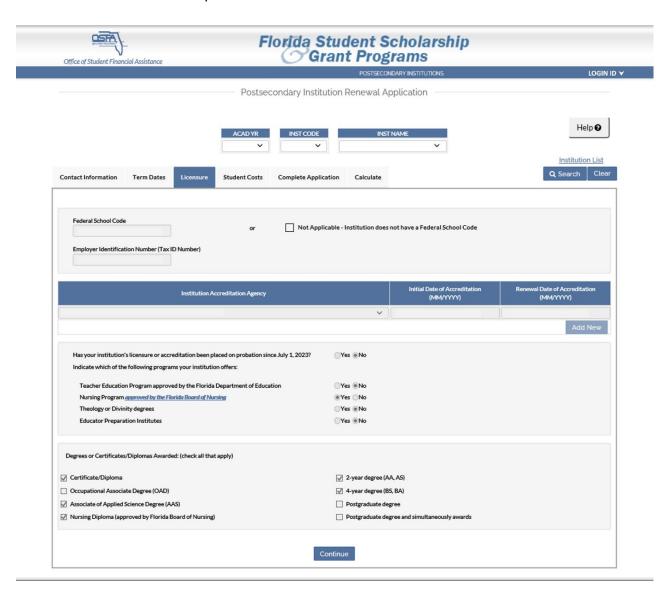
- This self-reported information, verified via the institution course catalog, determines the institution's Disbursement Eligibility Report (DER) dates.

Dates must be placed in all fields that pertain to the institution's term type.



Licensure

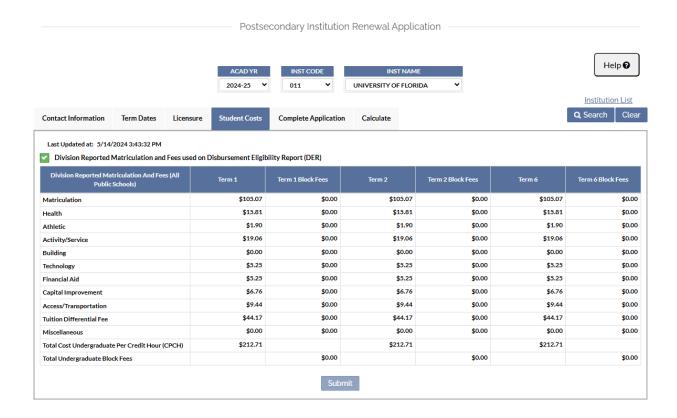
- Review pre-filled information and update any field that may be incorrect in the new academic year. Supply information in blank fields as needed.
- Links are available in some questions for additional information.



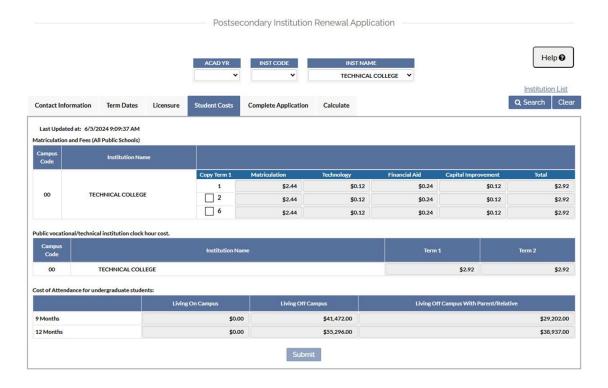
Student Costs

This section contains information related to matriculation and fees used on the DER.

- 4-year public state universities and 2-year public Florida College System institutions will not be required to provide matriculation and fee data because data will be provided directly to OSFA from the Board of Governors and the Division of Florida Colleges, respectively. When submitting the application, this section will be blank. Please continue to the next section.
- At a later date, institutions are encouraged to review the data displayed in this section for accuracy. See the image below for an example.



Public vocational/technical colleges are required to submit cost information that includes a breakdown of matriculation and fees that will result in a cost per credit hour being displayed by term.



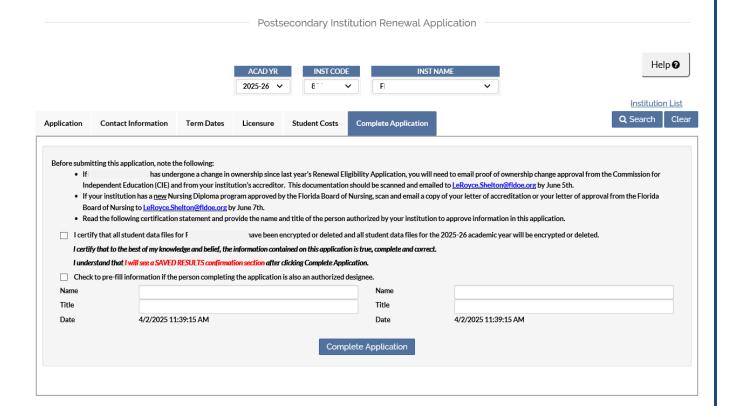
Private institutions and vocational/technical colleges are required to submit cost information that includes a flat rate cost per term for full-time undergraduate tuition and cost of attendance information.



Complete Application

All sections of the Application must be completed before the Complete Application section may be submitted.

- > Select the certification box to attest to the provided statement of encryption or deletion of all student files.
- Enter the Name, Title, and submission date indicating user who completed the Application.
- > The evaluation process will not begin until the Complete Application button is selected (no later than the date specified on the Application).

- A successful application submission will result in the information shown below that contains important information, including the state scholarship and grant programs the institution will be eligible to participate in.
